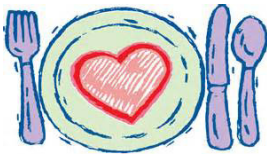
Knights of Columbus is once again offering a **\$600 College Scholarship (open to parish)**

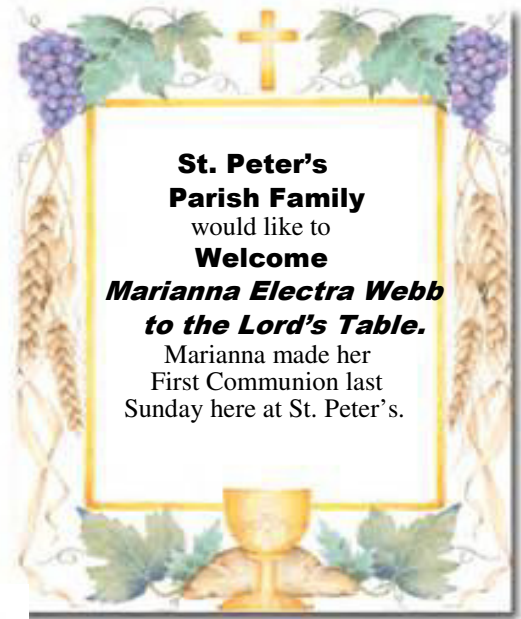
