St. Peter's Charitable Trust Finance Committee met in July and reviewed the year of 2016 financial actual's against the Budget. We are unfavorable in Net Income to Budget by \$5,824. Total Income was \$265,463 versus the Budget of \$245,140 up by \$20,323. This was mainly due to the Offertory up by \$9,757 and Unusual Income by \$10,209. The Offertory Income is continuing to show an increase over Budget, and we thank all our generous parishioners for their great support. The Unusual Income (non-scheduled) always budgeted at \$10,000 came in this year at \$20,209 with our sign and Atlas Sound System being among the new items purchased by anonymous parishioners. We thank all those who contributed to this account.

The actual expenses were \$231,869 versus the Budget of \$251,129 better by \$20,251. The main areas of lower spending were 5000-Youth Ministry Director left early, and she did not require medical insurance \$9,247 and the new YMD did not cost us anything until June. 5300-parking lot paving was moved out of this year's requirements \$7681: the building, repair & maintenance requirements were much lower than budgeted \$9826; offset by an increase in appliances, equipment & tools under 5K of \$7998; 5400-oil & gas usage cost were lower than budgeted by \$7354. Net Ordinary Income was \$36,687 better than budget by \$40,574. There was a Prior Period Adjustment for depreciation expense reducing our income to -\$11,813 worse than budget by \$5824. This prior expense and depreciation increase is due to recording the Parish Hall Renovations through depreciation.
