Fr. Yvon's Weekly Reflection Getting around the road blocks!

Dear Friends, in last week's reflections I talked about the reality of road blocks in our journey through life. As part of that reflection I asked you to ponder how we can work around these road blocks.

Here are my thoughts! 1) I believe the first thing that we need to do is acknowledge the presence of the barrier that is before us; 2) second quiet oneself in order to seek out God's Will through a private conversation with Him. In this conversation we need to take time to listen to God. The goal of doing this is to first ask "what is my mission and how am I being called to make the world a better place one person at a time" and second to take time to recognize what is happening around us so that we can make the changes in our lives that are needed to do His Will; 3) and third to seek out others who can assist us in the process of going around the road blocks and moving from where we are to where we are being called to be. Growth is not always easy, but it is important! May we all grow together!

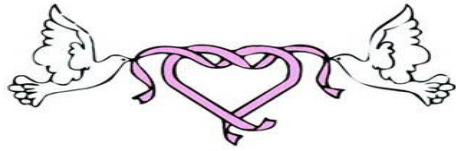
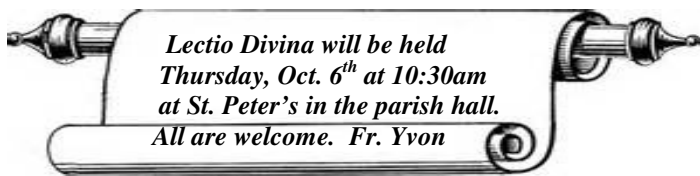
