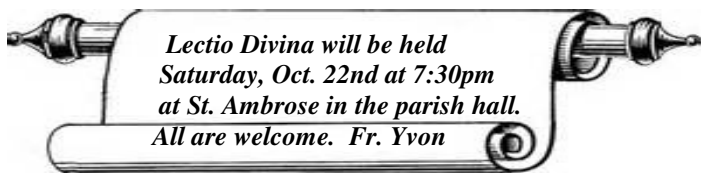

The 4th Degree Knights of Columbus Assembly # 1743 will meet on Monday, October 17th, at 7:00 PM in St. Mary's Parish Hall.

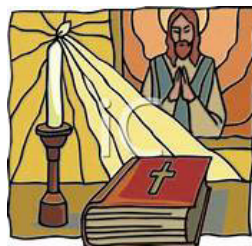
